

Transferring Credits from Israeli Universities (one-year program for overseas students)

The following revised guidelines are to be observed in the awarding of credit for courses taken at Hebrew University, as part of the One-Year Program for Overseas Students:

1. Credits are awarded only for courses with a grade of 68% or higher.
2. A maximum of 30 credits is awarded for the One Year Program and a maximum of 15 credits is awarded for the One Semester Program.
 - a. A maximum of 3 credits is awarded for each autumn or spring semester course.
3. A maximum of 3 credits is awarded for a one-semester (autumn or spring) course in Hebrew language.

Winter / Summer Ulpan

4. A maximum of 3 credits is awarded for the intensive (short) summer or winter Ulpan and a maximum of 6 credits is awarded for the full summer Ulpan.
5. All Hebrew language courses and Ulpans must be approved by the Department of Jewish Studies.

BGU cannot take <i>Introductory Hebrew</i> (JWST 220 D1&D2) or <i>Intensive Hebrew</i> (JWST 200C) at McGill University.
A student who has taken <i>Hebrew Language Semester, Level Bet – Lower Intermediate</i> (13-5-250) at BGU cannot take <i>Intermediate Hebrew</i> (JWST 320 D1&D2) at McGill University.
A student who has taken <i>Hebrew Language Semester, Level Gimel - Upper Intermediate</i> (13-5-350) at BGU cannot take <i>Advanced Hebrew</i> (JWST 340 D1&D2) at McGill University.
A student who has taken <i>Hebrew Language Semester, Level Dalet - pre-Advanced</i> (13-5-450) and <i>Hebrew Language Semester, Level Heh - Advanced</i> (13-5-551) at BGU can only take <i>Studies in Hebrew Lang. & Lit.</i> (JWST 367A/368B/369A/370B) at McGill University.

Students who have taken a course in Israel equivalent to one they have taken at McGill will not receive credit because of repetition.
